Tickets

- Every person entering the event must have a fair ticket because the fair is going on at the same time
- Each registered team will get 5 free tickets to use however they would like
- We will have a ticket pick up tent where one representative can pick up the teams tickets. This person will sign for the tickets
- Free tickets for students with ID's on Sunday for students in Citrus and Highland counties (must be redeemed at fair box office not team ticket pick up)
- Free Tickets for students with ID's on Monday for students Sarasota, Manatee, Polk and Pinellas counties (must be redeemed at fair box office not team ticket pick up)
- All volunteers will receive free tickets see volunteer links in past emails or robotevents.com
- Feel free to enter the fair during or after the championships
