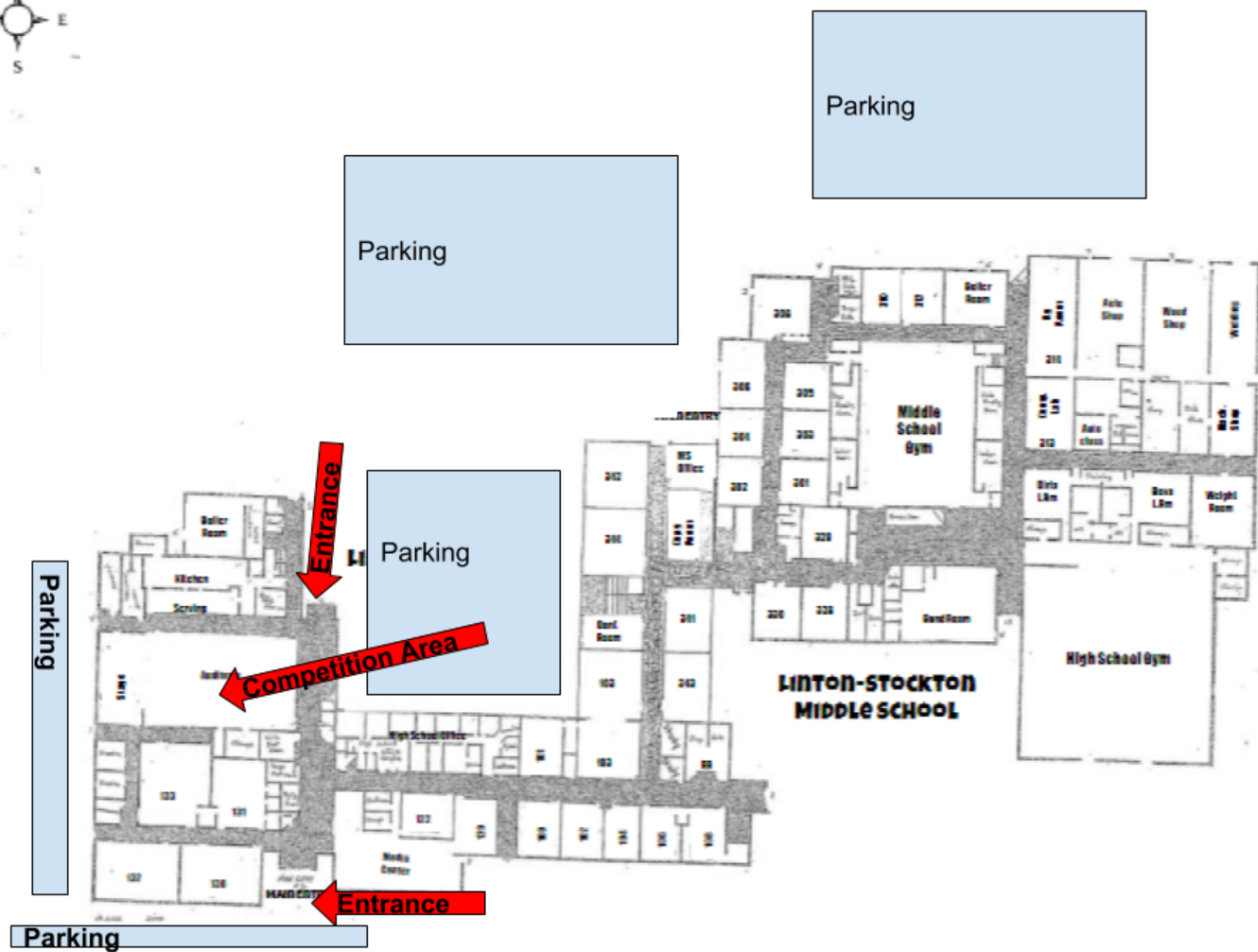

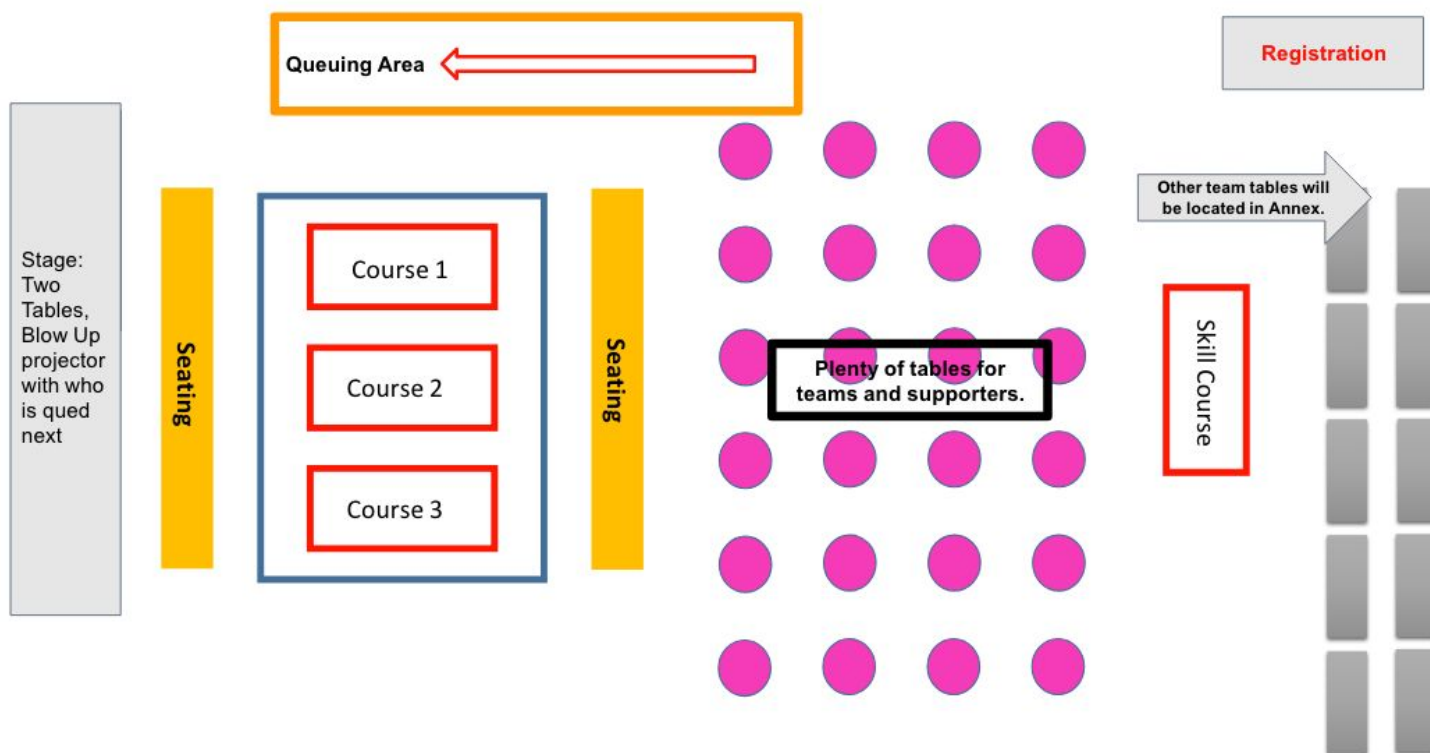


Linton-Stockton High School Layout

Competition will be held in the Linton-Stockton High School Auditoria. Additional team seating will be throughout annex and media center.



Agenda

This year we will not be providing a time schedule of matches until you arrive, so all teams must check in prior to 8:30 a.m.

- 7:30 a.m. – 8:30 a.m. Team Check In/Robot Inspection
- 9:00 a.m. Driver Meeting
- 9:15 a.m. Welcome Ceremony
- 9:30 a.m. Practice Round (each team will practice twice)
- 10:45 a.m. Teamwork matches (each team will compete 6-8 times-depends on drop or added teams on the day of)
- 3:15 p.m. Final Match Competition (Top ten)
- 3:30 p.m. Awards

Times may shift throughout the day depending upon tournament flow. Changes will be openly communicated throughout the day of the event.

Team Check-In Process: Teams may begin checking in at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday, January 18. Teams will have to complete the robot inspection prior to competing in matches. Teams should report to the check-in table upon arrival to check the team in. At check in, teams should complete the following tasks:

1. Robot Inspection. The Inspection Rubric will be used to make sure that the robot is compliant with VEX Competition Rules.
2. Waiver submissions. You will need to turn in the waiver for each of your students. You may also submit them online, which might save a forest. 😊
3. Submit Engineering Notebooks to be judged according to the rubrics provided online.

Competitions

The schedule for the matches will be made available at check-in. All teams will have the opportunity to compete in the following challenges:

Practice Challenge: Teams will have one practice match with teams chosen by the tournament manager software.

Teamwork Challenges: Teams will have 6-8 different matches where they work with other teams. These matches will be assigned by the tournament manager software the morning of the tournament. The amount of time and number of teams will determine the number of times each team will participate in a teamwork challenge. All teams will compete an equal number of times.

Driving Skills Challenge: Teams will have the opportunity to complete the course two times during the competition at a time of their own choosing. This course can be found in the back of the room and will be labeled “Skills Challenge Course”. Teams will have two rubrics placed at their team table for this competition. When teams are ready to compete, they should bring their rubric with them to the competition table.

Programming Skills Challenge: Teams will have the opportunity to complete the programming skills challenge twice. This challenge consists of drivers using autonomous programming to complete the course. It is not a requirement for teams to complete this challenge.

Final Alliances: After the completion of all the teamwork matches, the top ten ranked teams will compete for the chance to win the Teamwork Challenge Award, which qualifies both teams for the State Tournament. The teams will compete as follows:

10th ranked team with the 9th ranked team

8th ranked team with the 7th ranked team

6th ranked team with the 5th ranked team

4th ranked team with the 3rd ranked team

2nd ranked team with the 1st ranked team

The alliance with the highest score from this challenge will win the award. Previous rounds of the tournament do not affect this outcome.

Awards

The following awards will be given out at the competition. The definition of the award is provided.

Excellence Award (2): Highest award presented. This team exemplifies overall excellence by being a strong contender in numerous award categories. Excellence winners **must** have an Engineering Notebook.

Teamwork Champion Award (2): Awarded to the two teams that scored the highest score on the Teamwork Challenge together.

Design Award (1): Awarded to the team that demonstrates the ability to implement the most effective and efficient robot design process. Teams **must** submit engineering notebook to be considered for the award.

Robot Skills Award (1): Awarded to the team with the highest combined Programming Skills Challenge and Driving Skills Challenge.

Judges Award (1): Teams deserving recognition from judges.

In consideration of My participation in one or more VEX® Robotics Competition events, I agree to the following:

I hereby grant VEX Robotics the right to photograph, videotape, or otherwise digitally record or collect My name, biography, image, likeness, voice, sounds, plus any other information I provide, associated with My attendance at and/or participation in any VEX® Robotics Competition events. I further acknowledge that any works made by or for VEX Robotics ("Works") to be "works made for hire," under applicable copyright laws, and to the extent I have or may claim any rights in or to such Works, I hereby grant to VEX Robotics any and all such rights, including, without limitation, the right to use or sublicense these Works in any and all media, now known or later discovered or developed, and in all forms and for all purposes, including without limitation, advertising and other promotions for VEX® Robotics Competition and Vex Robotics Competition events, without any further consideration due to Me or any limitation whatsoever.
