



Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Visitor Self-Assessment

April 18, 2022

Each time a visitor wishes to enter an Allegion facility, they are asked to review this self-assessment before entering; this includes vendors, community leaders, job interview candidates, suppliers, manufacturing representatives, technicians and other visitors to our site. Hosts are asked to send the assessment approximately 48 hours in advance of the visit, or as soon as practical. Information will not be collected or recorded.

Note: *The visitor will be asked to review the self-assessment again when they arrive at our facility and, of course, if their health condition deteriorates, they should reschedule the visit or meet virtually. We encourage visitors traveling to an Allegion site to understand the trend in COVID-19 cases in both their departure and arrival locations. If a visitor does not have information regarding COVID-19 case trends, please ask them to check local government/health officials' resources or you can contact your local Allegion EHS leader for help. In addition, any exceptions regarding a visitor's recent travel (see the first question) must be pre-approved by the site's leader and/or local EHS leader.*

EXCLUDED from this self-assessment are delivery trucks, contingent labor workers, and other contractors who work out of an Allegion facility on a daily basis and are expected to adhere to Allegion's COVID-19 protocols.

Do **ANY** of the following apply to you within the past 14 days? **If you answer YES to any of these questions, do not come into our facility. Instead, contact your host to make other arrangements or reschedule the appointment.**

Q. Are you traveling from an outside geographic area (province/state) that currently has an upward trend in COVID-19 cases? OR

Q. Have you tested positive for COVID-19? OR

Q. Have you been exposed (or do you even suspect you've been exposed) to a suspected/confirmed COVID-19 case? OR

Q. Are you sick (whether COVID-19 or not), showing symptoms of COVID-19 or other illnesses, or starting to feel sick?

- Answer "yes" if any of the following are present: fever (within the past 72 hours); new loss of taste or smell; new dry cough; shortness of breath; difficulty breathing; or chills.
- Answer "yes" if any combination of the following are present: muscle or body aches; fatigue; headache; nausea; diarrhea; congestion; sore throat; or conjunctivitis (pink eye).
